Mr. Opeyemi Agbaje

r. Opeyemi Agbaje is the Founder and CEO of RTC Advisory Services Ltd and was recently appointed Chairman of the National Pension Commission (PenCom) by President Bola Ahmed Tinubu. With over four decades of post-graduation experience, he is a distinguished finance, investment, and strategy professional whose multidisciplinary career spans law, banking, academia, consulting, and public policy. Widely recognised as a thought leader in business, economy, and governance, Mr. Agbaje's contributions continue to shape Nigeria's financial and policy landscape.

He graduated with honours in Law from the University of Ife (now Obafemi Awolowo University) in 1985, and was called to the Nigerian Bar in 1986. He obtained an LLM from the University of Lagos in 1989, an MBA from IESE Business School, Spain in 1997, and is completing a Doctorate in Business Administration from Eaton Business School.

Mr. Agbaje began his career at the Directorate of Public Prosecutions in the old Bendel State Ministry of Justice, later working at Kola Awodein & Co (SAN) and the Legal Department of First Bank of Nigeria Plc. In 1990, he became a foundation staff of GTBank, where he rose to Assistant General Manager within eight years, and ultimately served as Executive Director before transitioning out of mainstream banking in 2004.

Since then, he has led RTC Advisory Services Ltd, a pioneering indigenous consultancy providing expertise in economy, policy, strategy, and organisational transformation. Alongside this, he has played a pivotal role in academia—teaching Business Strategy and the Environment of Business at Lagos Business School since 1999, where he also served as Senior Fellow and Head of the Strategy and Entrepreneurship Department.

Beyond academia, Mr. Agbaje is a respected policy commentator. His widely-read Economy, Polity, Society column ran in BusinessDay Newspaper from 2006 to 2019, while his policy-focused television programme, The Policy Council, aired on Channels TV from 2011 to 2015.

He has also served on several boards, including the Lagos State Security Trust Fund (2011-2019), the Ogun State Security Trust Fund (2019-2021), and Chemical and Allied Products Plc (2011-2019). He chaired The Convention on Business Integrity and is currently a Director of FCSL Finance Company Ltd, one of Nigeria's oldest licensed finance institutions.

Mr. Agbaje has received numerous honours, including the Igbobi College National Merit Award for Professional Excellence (2019). He is a Knight of John Wesley (KJW) in the Methodist Church, a philanthropist, and a devoted family man, married with adult children.
